The DB3 was designed by Robert Eberan von Eberhorst, the noted Austrian engineer who, pre war, had designed the Auto Union Type D Grand Prix car. The DB35 was first built as an open racing car before a fixed head coupe was designed by Frank Feeley for racing on high speed circuits. The design was tested in the wind tunnel facility at Brooklands before its first race at Silverstone but it failed to impress.
